
- 13) To accept gifts and endorsements on such terms as the institute may consider reasonable.

d) SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING:


Special General meeting shall be called by the president within a month at any time by resolution in writing signed by not less than 2/3 members of the general body.


17. QUORUM OF THE MEETING:

The trust i.e. 'Jeevan Prabodhini, Vita Mu.Po. Gardi, Tal. Khanapur, Dist. Sangli P.T.R. No. F-8890(Sangli)' (In short, the 'trust') through applicant namely *Shri. Jayant Maruti Kadam* has filed this change report under Section 22 of the Maharashtra Public Trusts Act, 1950 for the change occurred in the trust due to tenure completion of executive council and office bearers.

2. In short, the case of the applicant is as follows:-

It is contended by the applicant that, the tenure of earlier executive council and office bearers had elapsed. Thus, trust held annual general meeting on 21.09.2022 for the election of members in the executive council. In the said meeting new executive council was elected for the period of 2022 to 2027. Thereafter, in the executive council meeting dated 03.10.2022 new office bearers were elected for further period of

2022 to 2027. Therefore, the present change report has been filed with this office.

3. Delay caused for filing change report has been condoned vide order passed below (Exh.02) dated 11.05.2023 subject to penalty of Rs.100/- (One Hundred Only).

4. Heard the learned advocate appearing for the applicant. I have gone through the documents filed on record. The points for determination, along with my findings thereon with the reasons are as follows:-

REASONS AND FINDINGS

AS TO POINT NO. 01 :-

5. In order to prove the present change report the applicant namely. *Shri. Jayant Kadam* has following documents on record.

6. The applicant has also filed his affidavit in lieu of examination-in-chief at (Exh.31). Upon perusal of record and proceedings it shows that, the present trust is registered with this office vide P.T.R. No. F-8890/Sangli. As per clause (13) of rules and regulations of present trust the tenure of executive council is of five years. The procedure of election is given in clause (13, 14 and 15). Thereafter, office bearers shall be elected by executive council in their first meeting. Adhere to this, in the annual general meeting of the trust dated 21.09.2022 vide resolution no. 02 new executive council was elected for further period of 2022 to 2027. The notice of annual general meeting was issued by the secretary of the trust to all its members. Thereafter, as per rules and regulations executive council held their meeting dated 03.10.2022 by way of notice dated 23.09.2022. In the executive council meeting dated 03.10.2022 vide resolution no. 02, 03 and 04 office bearers were elected for the period of five years i.e. from 2022 to 2027. The record shows that, all the members in the executive council had been remained present for the executive council meeting and the resolution has been passed unanimously. Consent letter and no objection letter of its members is filed on record. Last change report of the trust Change Report No.2103/2018 for the tenure 2017 to 2022 is accepted by previous authority. The change report is exclusively uncontested one. Hence, I do not find any legal impediment to accept the present change report.
